## DOE Announces \$70 Million for Cybersecurity Institute for Energy Efficient Manufacturing

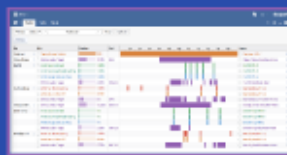
